5. General Manager's Report

Kerry Burridge, MBA General Manager presented a report which covered the Progress Report 2020/2021, Business Plan 2021/2022 and Budgets for 2021/2022 & 2022/2023.

a) **Progress Report 2020/2021 and Business Plan 2021/2022** A number of our projects have been interrupted this year due to the effects of the Covid19 lockdown.

CCTV Project – Stage 1 of the CCTV Project is complete. We are over halfway through Stage 2 which has seen delays due to Covid19. Our partner SaferCities will be continuing with installations and Stage 2 will be complete by the end of June 2022. **Marketing Project** – We are continuing to work on our marketing project to attract businesses, shoppers, students and residents to our district. We have commissioned Saturday Creative to help us with this. The market research part of the project is nearly complete and we will be working on a brand design for Manukau next. **Strategic Plan 2022-2025** – Our current Strategic Plan expires June 2022. We have just engaged the services of a consultant and will be working on this throughout this financial year, in readiness for July 2022.

b) Budgets 2021 - 2023

Proposed Budget for 2021/2022 – Move to adopt the proposed 2021/2022 budget including the BID targeted rate of \$510,000. Note this is the same BID targeted rate amount for the 2020/2021 financial year.

Proposed Budget for 2022/2023 – Move to adopt and approve the 2022/2023 budget which includes a BID targeted rate amount of \$525,300 noting there will be a 3%



increase of \$15,300 to the BID targeted rate for the 2022/2023 financial year. Further ask the Otara-Papatoetoe Local Board to recommend to the governing body the amount of \$525,300 be included in the Auckland Council draft 2022/2023 annual budget consultation process.
